

COVID-19 Post-Exposure Testing

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the N.C. Department of Health and Human Services recommend testing for individuals who have been in close contact with a confirmed or probable Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) patient. But when a COVID-19 exposure occurs at work, multiple people may be affected making it challenging for employers to manage.

Because employers' needs vary, Atrium Health has created several different pathways for COVID-19 testing following an exposure at work.



ON-SITE Rapid Testing

- Ideal for workplace exposures that involve multiple employees
- Employers are direct billed for all fees
- Employees receive results in 15 minutes at the point of care
- Good option for essential workers
- Symptomatic patients will be tested for COVID-19 as well as flu during flu season



ON-SITE COLLECTION for Lab Testing

- Ideal for workplace exposures that involve multiple employees
- Employers have the option to bill through insurance
 - A separate convenience fee is direct billed to the employer to cover costs associated with delivering the service at the worksite
- Employees receive results within 2-4 days
- Only asymptomatic (showing no symptoms) employees will be tested



URGENT CARE Testing

- Ideal for smaller workplace exposures that involve only a few employees
- Testing can be direct billed to the employer or billed through the employee's insurance
- Testing is offered along with a provider assessment, at over 30 Urgent Care locations for convenient access
- The rapid test is available for symptomatic and asymptomatic patients and delivers results in 15 minutes
- Symptomatic patients will be tested for COVID-19 as well as flu during flu season
 - If a confirmatory lab test is indicated, patients will receive those separate results within 2-4 days
- Available for employees, families, and dependents of all ages
